

Pathology Billing Information

Baylor Pathology Laboratory is pleased to provide individual examination and interpretation for specimen (s) obtained by your health provider at Sadler Clinic. There are two components to your Pathology billing – the technical component and the professional (or reporting) component. Sadler Clinic will bill your insurance company for the technical component, which includes the fee for collection and processing of specimen. Baylor Community Pathology will bill your insurance company for the actual interpretation of the specimen submitted.

Depending on your specific insurance carrier, you may owe a co-payment before the exam is performed and may have a patient balance after the insurance carrier pays your claim. If there is a patient balance owed, Sadler Clinic will bill you directly for the technical component and Baylor Community Pathology will bill you for the professional component; thus, you may receive two separate bills for your biopsy specimen.
